## The Village Green

Montville Village Hall and the Village Green have been the hub of Montville community life since the town's earliest days. The Village Hall was completed in 1903 and its gates are a war memorial erected after World War I, along with an avenue of six weeping figs to honour the six Montville men who died in that war. The memorial gates not only list men who enlisted but also six "rejects" who volunteered for service but weren't accepted on age or medical grounds. Today the Village Green and Village Hall host community events including the monthly Montville markets which are held on the second Saturday of each month.

## Russell Family Park

Russell Family Park was previously farm land owned by the Russell family. Today, it includes two playgrounds, a stand of bunya pines, a rainforest regeneration area and a lagoon. In days gone by, the lagoon was a gathering point for Aboriginal people, timber-getters who watered their bullocks at the lagoon and local children who used it as a swimming pool.

## Montville State School

Montville State School was established in 1896 and initially known as Razorback Provisional School. The original Razorback school house is still on the school grounds and can be seen from the road that runs beside the northern edge of the school. Ceramic tiles in the footpath near the school depict the school's early days and other local history.
